- Aviation-related jobs account for nearly 16.8% of all employment in Arizona.
- Arizona ranks fifth in the U.S. in the number of active general aviation aircraft and its general aviation airports are among the most active in the country.
- Nearly 409,000 jobs in Arizona are in some way related to the aviation industry. Over \$58 billion in economic impact is created by the industry each year.
- An estimated 9.9 million out-of-state visitors came to Arizona in 2011 by air, 74 percent of whom arrived by commercial airlines.

June 22, 1942 – Scottsdale Airport opens as Thunderbird Field II, a training airfield for Army Corps Airmen

1953 – Airport acquired by the Arizona Seventh Day Adventists and used as a training facility under the name Thunderbird Academy

1966 – City of Scottsdale purchases the airfield to operate as a municipal airport
